

#### **File 4 – transcript**

Interview between Aksa and Katy, members of the Meet and Mingle group who took part in oral history sessions in March 2013.

Aksa: My name is Aksa Marshal and I'm going interview a lady and she's going to tell you what her name is – Hello.

Katy: Hello, my name is Katy and I'm going to tell you about this letter I have about from 20 years ago, written by my mum to me. She was in Pakistan and she is no more...that was the only letter she wrote me ever in her life. It's written in Urdu, it's about, erm, a very private letter, about a family matter it is written, but it mean a lot to me because it was written only once and when my mother died, then I kept it since then, I kept it with me and I think, erm, as long as I will live, I will keep it with me.

Aksa: And how old were you Katy when you when you go this letter and where were you?

Katy: I was here, married in England, er, 20 years ago. I got this letter in 19, I think, 1992, I believe or 91, I got this letter.
