Administrative/biographical history

Avinash Chandra was born in 1931 in Simla, India. After studying painting and teaching in New Dehli he moved to London in 1956. He went on to exhibit across Europe including several UK cities. Initially a landscape painter, specialising in depicting Indian towns, his preoccupations developed into an interest in female nudes and later in murals. His work is held in several national collections including the Tate Gallery, the Victoria and Albert Museum and the Musee d'Art Moderne, Paris. He died in 1991.

Immediate source of acquisition

The collection was deposited as part of the SADAA (formerly SALIDAA).

Scope and content

This collection mainly consists of photocopies of biographical and critical articles on the artist Avinash Chandra. Additionally, there are several original exhibition postcards and advertisements. Also included is a video recording and a CD containing images of the artist's work.
