Administrative/biographical history

Sunil Gupta was born in India in 1953. He was educated in Canada and the UK. He is a photographer who has exhibited in Europe and North America as well as in India. An artist who has produced films and video, he has curated exhibitions as well as writing and lecturing. As a gay man with HIV, he has produced work on the experiences of gay men in India and elsewhere.

Immediate source of acquisition

This collection is part of the The South Asian Diaspora Literature and Arts Archive (SALIDAA) which was founded in 1999. The aim was to preserve sources and information about the contribution of the South Asian community to literature and arts in Britain.

SALIDAA deposited part of their archive with Brunel University Special Collections.

This collection looks at some of his exhibited work, especially “Pictures from here,” and “From here to eternity.”
